Motorsport world governing bodies (UIM, FIA and FIM) join forces on Environment, Alternative Energies and Sustainable Development

The three motorsport world governing bodies (UIM, FIA and FIM) jointly met for the first time in Riccione at the UIM General Assembly.

The meeting chaired by the UIM President was attended by senior officers of the Federation Internationale de l'Automobile (FIA) – AEC Commission, Federation Internationale de Motocyclisme (FIM) and Union Internationale Motonautique (UIM).

The three motorsports world bodies presented their views in a constructive atmosphere and agreed to jointly focus on:

- Optimal use of resources
- Reduction of pollution
- Reduction of noise

Initial common actions were discussed and agreed upon.

The next operational meeting will be held in Monaco.

To expedite this program the UIM has created a dedicate Working Group.

“I’m really proud that UIM hosted this historical first meeting during our UIM General Assembly”, said the UIM President Raffaele Chiulli, “sharing experiences with other International Motorsport Federations and joining efforts will facilitate the transfer of knowledge.
